This agreement serves to confirm the following:

-  All animals in foster care are legally owned by Happy Yappers Animal Sanctuary.
-  Happy Yappers Animal Sanctuary will make all decisions regarding the adoption & placement of the animals fostered.
-  The foster parent is not to promise the animal to anyone, or imply that you have the authority to approve a potential adoption.
-  At any time that the foster parent can no longer care for the animal, the animal should be returned to the care of Happy Yappers and may not under any circumstances be rehomed outside of the Happy Yappers adoption / foster process.
-  You will be expected to keep the animal safe and secure and return it to Happy Yappers when requested to do so.
-  Happy Yappers undertakes to providing all food and bedding for the animal while it is in their care at home; unless the foster parents choose to provide such themselves.
-  Happy Yappers reserve the right to uplift any dog/puppy at any time if we feel the animal is not receiving the correct care, shelter and nutrition as promised by the foster care provider.
-  The foster parent is responsible for transporting the animals to and from Happy Yappers for veterinary appointments, surgery, behaviour evaluations, vaccinations, etc.
-  The foster parent undertakes, to safeguard the animal to the best of their ability including, not taking the animal to parks or for walks until fully vaccinated.
-  The foster parent may also be responsible for transporting the animal to and from adoption events.
-  Happy Yappers do not accept liability for the behaviour or temperament of the animal.

- 🐾 Happy Yappers cannot be held liable for any loss of property, damage or injury as a result of fostering this animal.
- 🐾 All information filled out by the foster applicant is true and correct and it is understood that any false information may lead to the confiscation of the animal.
- 🐾 Happy Yappers have the right to refuse any foster application without reason.
